**CRITERIA FOR AWARD**

Nominations will be judged by a panel of preservation professionals on the excellence of a project according to the definitions of the following award categories.

- Restoration
- Landscape

- Compatible New Construction
- Green/Sustainable/LEED certified
- Stewardship
- Community Commitment and Revitalization

**NOMINATION REQUIREMENTS- TO BE CONSIDERED**

**PLEASE SUBMIT:**

- Hard copy of nomination
- Digital copy of nomination on a Windows compatible CD or by email.
- Minimum of 2 digital images of the project digital form. For buildings an exterior image is required. Images should be submitted on the same CD that includes all other nomination material.
- All images shall be labeled and include a credit line for publication. Before and after images are encouraged as well as close up shots of details, images that show the nominated subject in the context of its surroundings such as campus and community.
- Start and completion dates of projects
- Architect, Designer, Planner, and Contractor information
- Description including historical significance, challenges of the project and how they were overcome, individuals that made significant difference in the success of the project and the impact it has had on the campus and or community.
- Up 5 letters of support (optional)
- List of awards received (if applicable)

**ELIGIBILITY**

- Any historic preservation project on a landscape, building, object or site, including the integration of historic preservation into a masterplan, at a higher education or secondary school.
- Nominated projects must have been completed within the past several years (1-4).
- Self-nominations are welcome.
- The nomination process is open to anyone who would like to recognize project for its excellence (school, architecture, design construction or planning firm, subcontractor, craftsman, consultant, vendor, alumni, Trustee, donor, etc.)

**NOMINATION PROCEDURES**

- Nominations must conform to the requirements included in this nomination form and must be complete. Any additional material that supports a nominated project will be accepted.
- Complete submissions must be received by February 15, 2011
- Not all submitted nominations will be award recipients
